**Skip Bertman** (LSU) Skip Bertman's unyielding desire to succeed drove him to the pinnacle of his profession, and his astute knowledge of the game -- obtained from over 40 years of coaching -- combined with his steadfast determination and irrepressible enthusiasm transformed LSU Baseball into the nation's premier program. Bertman has been inducted into the College Baseball Hall of Fame, the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame and the American Baseball

Coaches Association Hall of Fame. He has had 5 National Championships, 7 SEC Championships, his Career Record is 870-330-3 (.724) (1984-2001), NCAA Tournament Record 89-29 (.754) highest winning percentage in NCAA history, 6 National Coach of The Year & 11 College World Series Appearances.



**Dave Serrano** (UT) A veteran of seven College World Series and one of just 11 coaches to lead two different programs to Omaha, Serrano arrives at Rocky Top with a career record of 289-139-1 (.675) in seven seasons as a Division I head coach. After leading UC Irvine to the 2007 CWS in his third year at the helm of the Anteaters, he moved on to Cal State Fullerton where he averaged 43.75 wins per season in his four campaigns with the Titans, including an

appearance in Omaha in 2009. Serrano, 46, returns to the site of his first Division I job, as he served two seasons as an assistant coach at Tennessee from 1995-96, following seven years at Cerritos Junior College.



**Mark Pickle** (Columbia Central H.S. & Southern Athletic Fields) Coach Pickle played at Marshall County High School and MTSU before becoming head coach at Columbia in 1998. During that time he has led his teams to 189 wins and two straight appearances in the state tournament.



**Larry Day** (Vanderbilt) Larry Day is in his third season with the Commodores and will once again work with the catchers and assist with the hitters. A 2007 graduate of Connecticut, Day was a four-year starter for the Huskies and earned All-Big East honors his junior year. He was drafted in the by the New York Yankees in 2007 draft and played for the Gulf Coast League Yankees and the Charleston River Dogs.



**Tom Griffin** (Carson-Newman) Tom Griffin will enter his seventh season as head baseball coach at Carson-Newman in 2011-2012. In his six years at Mossy Creek, the New Jersey-native has looked right at home as the head coach of the Eagles. He has compiled an overall record of 192-127 and a conference record of 81-53 during his six years at Carson Newman.



**Clay Greene** (Univ. of Memphis) Clay Greene was named assistant coach and recruiting coordination at University of Memphis in the summer of 2011 and will instruct the hitters and outfielders. Greene spent the last six seasons working with the hitters at East Tennessee State, while also serving as recruiting coordinator. ETSU claimed a program-best 36 wins in 2011.



**Lance Parrish** was one of the top catchers of the 1970s, 1980s & 1990s. In a 19-year major league career, he hit 324 home runs, won 3 Gold Gloves, and was named to 8 All-Star teams. As part of the great 1984 Tigers who won 111 games, he hit 33 home runs and finished in the MVP voting.



**Tommy Pharr** (Christian Academy of Knoxville) Coach Pharr won his 600th game leading CAK to their first state tournament appearance this past year. While coaching at Farragut High School he led his teams to 5 state tournament titles and 4 state runner-ups.
